

**September 1 – 9, 2025 (9 Days) ~ Spectacular Upper Canada Fall Tour to St. Jacobs, Niagara Falls & Thousand Islands Sunset Dinner Cruise & City Tour of Historical Kingston.**



**September 1:** Welcome aboard everyone as we leave for an awesome Fall Vacation which entails some of Canada's most beautiful places to visit.

**As the afternoon comes to an end, I have arranged a delicious Amish Group Dinner right here in the Amish Country at Anna Mae's Restaurant (included). After our Group Dinner we will check into the beautiful Hampton Inn by Hilton, located within walking distance of the famous St. Jacobs Farmers Market,**

**September 6: After a restful sleep and a scrumptious breakfast you will have a free day to explore and visit Canada's largest Farmer's Market with over 500 Vendors offering variety beyond imagination. "Treasure's Galore" You will have plenty of time to stroll along and enjoy the sights. Amish Tour Rides leave from the Market through-out the day so you might want to take the opportunity and join a Tour. There is also Outlet shopping within walking distance. Enjoy your day!!**

**September 7: After breakfast today, we will have to say good-bye to beautiful St. Jacobs as we travel on our way to Historical Kingston – Canada's First Capital arriving early afternoon. We will overnight at the Quality Inn & Suites, but first we will welcome on board Ray a local tour guide who will enlighten us about the Historical City of Kingston. Macdonald, Canada's first prime minister, and boasts North America's oldest continuously-running public market in Market Square, behind Kingston City Hall — itself a National Historic site.**

I have arranged a "Thousand Islands Sunset Dinner Cruise" for you which includes a 3-course meal, live music along with the spectacular scenery of the Thousand Islands.
